It recognizes the unity of God and His Prophets, upholds the principle of an unfettered search after truth, condemns all forms of superstition and prejudice, teaches that the fundamental purpose of religion is to promote concord and harmony, that it must go hand-in-hand with science, and that it constitutes the sole and ultimate basis of a peaceful, ordered, and progressive society.

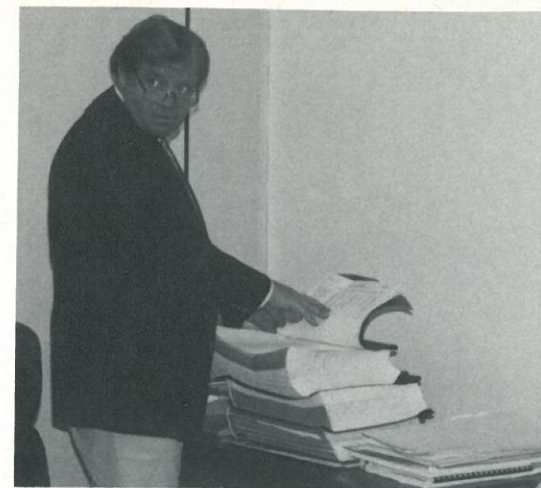
Acting President's Message Dr. Ed. Luterbach

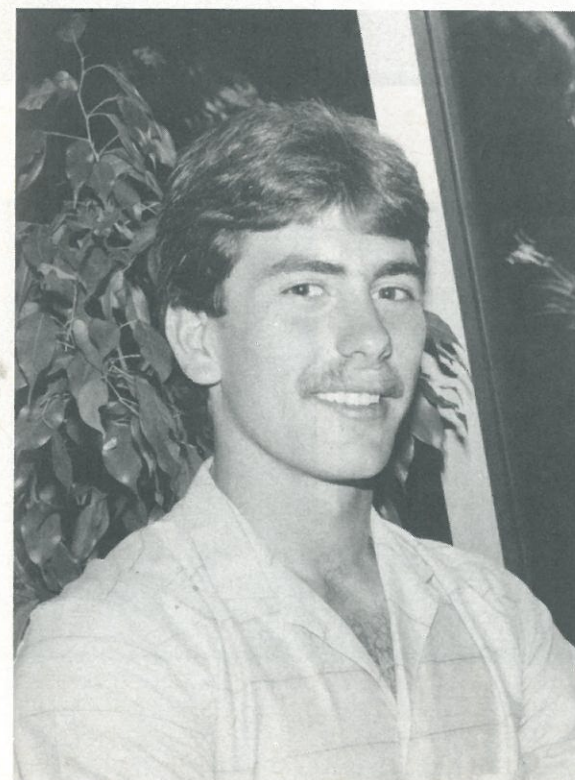
Executive Vice- President's Message

The Bricklayer has been functioning since 1972. Up until 5 years ago, the Bricklayer was an underground paper. But after years of waiting we finally surfaced.

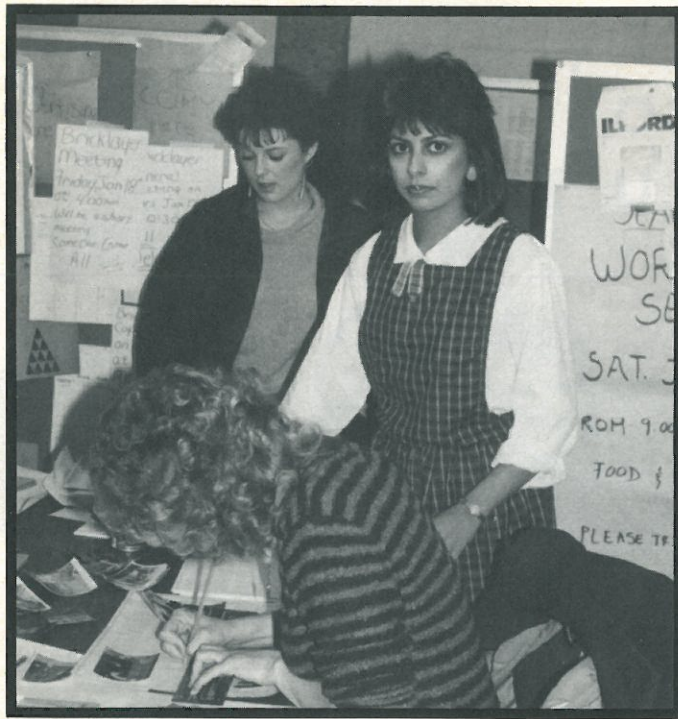
Our purpose this year was to produce a quality paper that tastefully voices students' views and communicate students' voice to other students, faculty, administration and the general public.

Not only do you meet new people, but you learn different aspects of business.

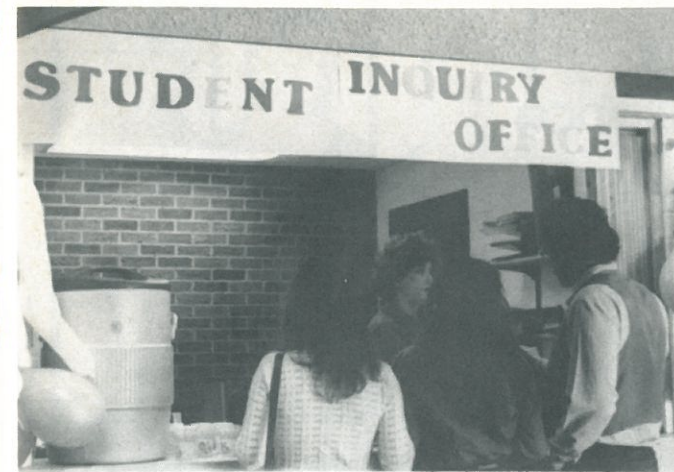

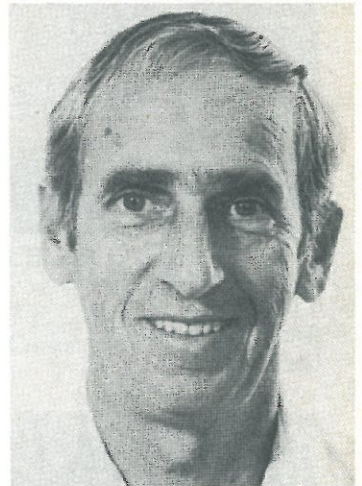
1984-85 TEAM PROSPECTUS

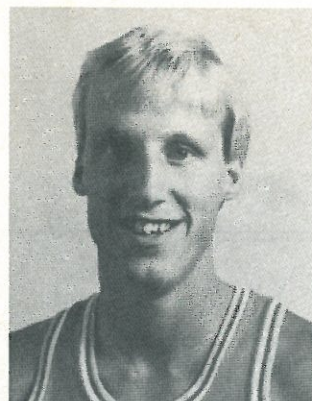

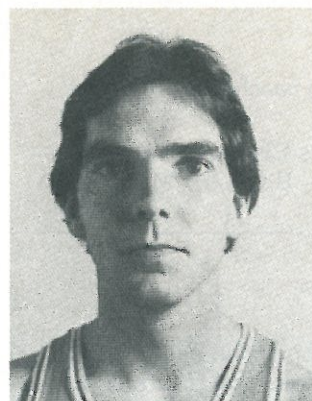

Overall, RDC placed second to SAIT in the golf supremacy.





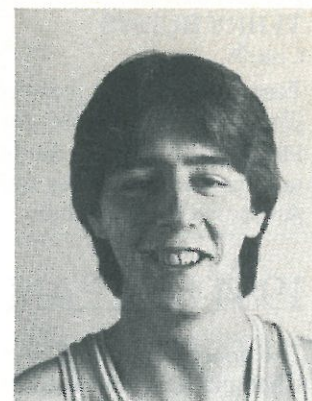

However, we look toward an overall strong team performance this year with emphasis on having the team members gain competitive experience through play against local ranked players and more tournament play.



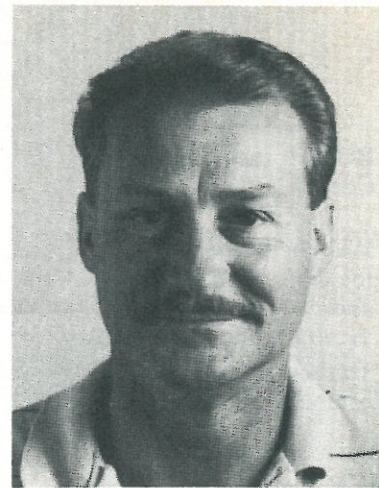
College Queens

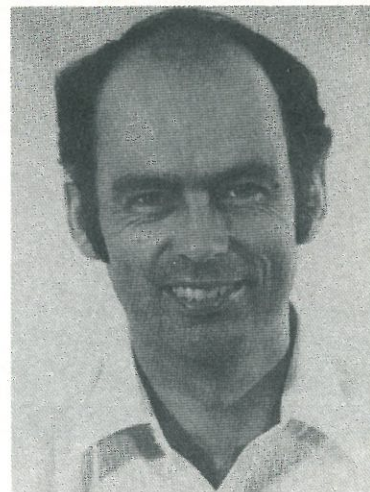
Cross-Country Running

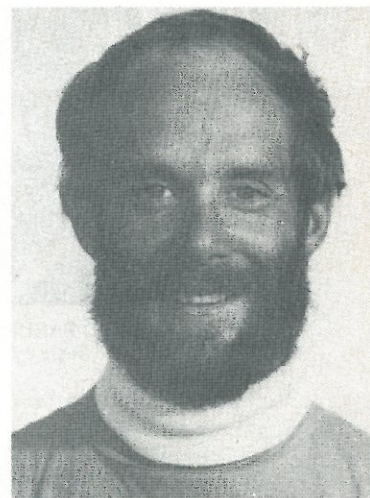
Cross-Country Skiing

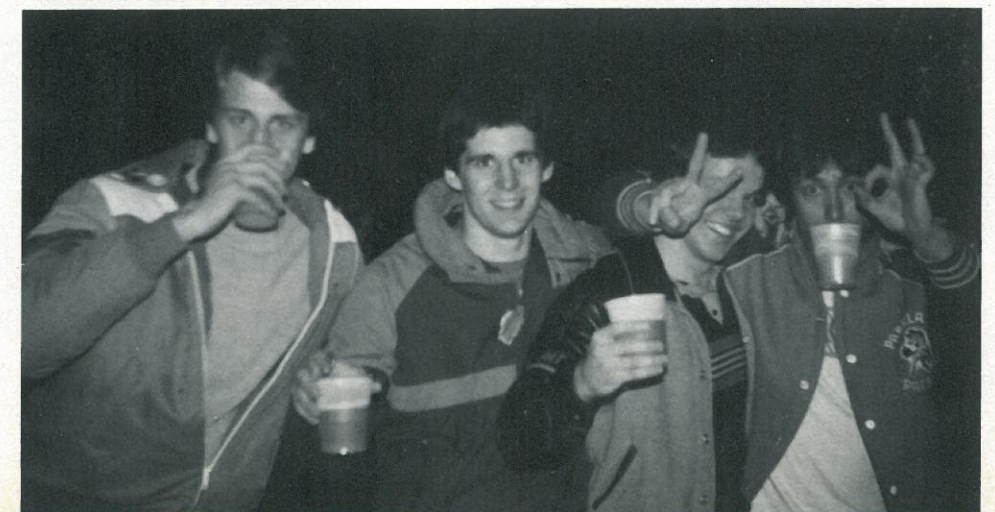
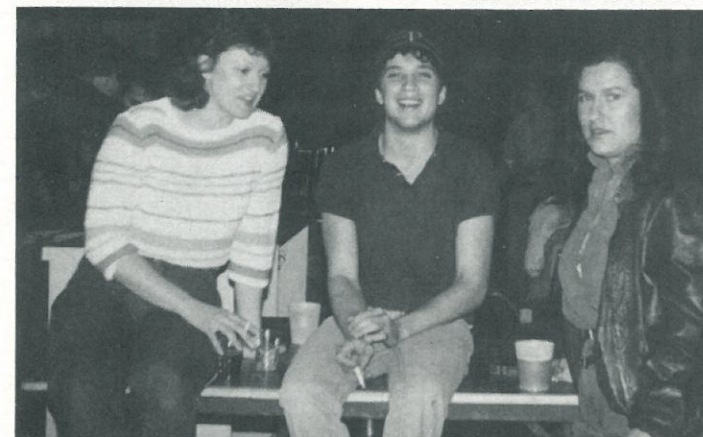
1984-85 TEAM PROSPECTUS
