RDC experienced a night of rockin' reggae with One. This band brought a special brand of music to the students that very few have heard. If you missed them this year make sure to catch them next year.

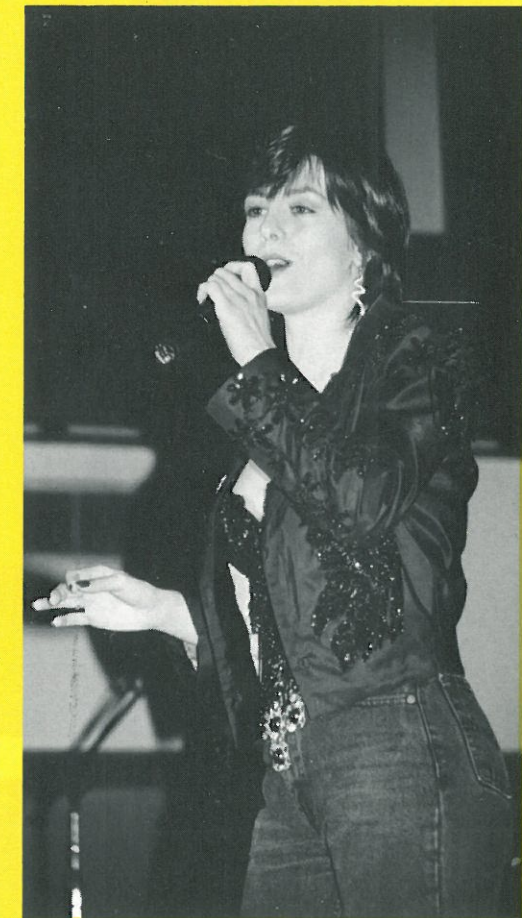

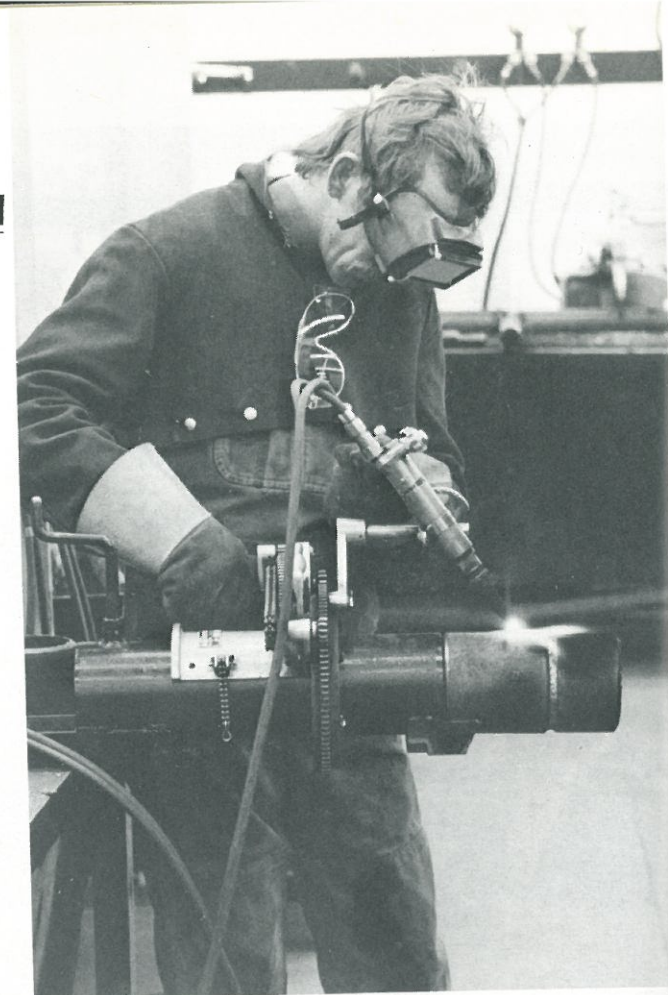

The two year Sky Wings Aviation Diploma Program, in conjunction with Red Deer College, was initiated in May 1990. Beginning with 13 students, the Aviation program has developed into a valuable asset for individuals looking to pursue a career in aviation. Twenty four students were accepted in January 1991, with another thirty seven to begin in January 1992. Students train in a fleet of eight single engine aircrafts, one twin and two flight simulators.

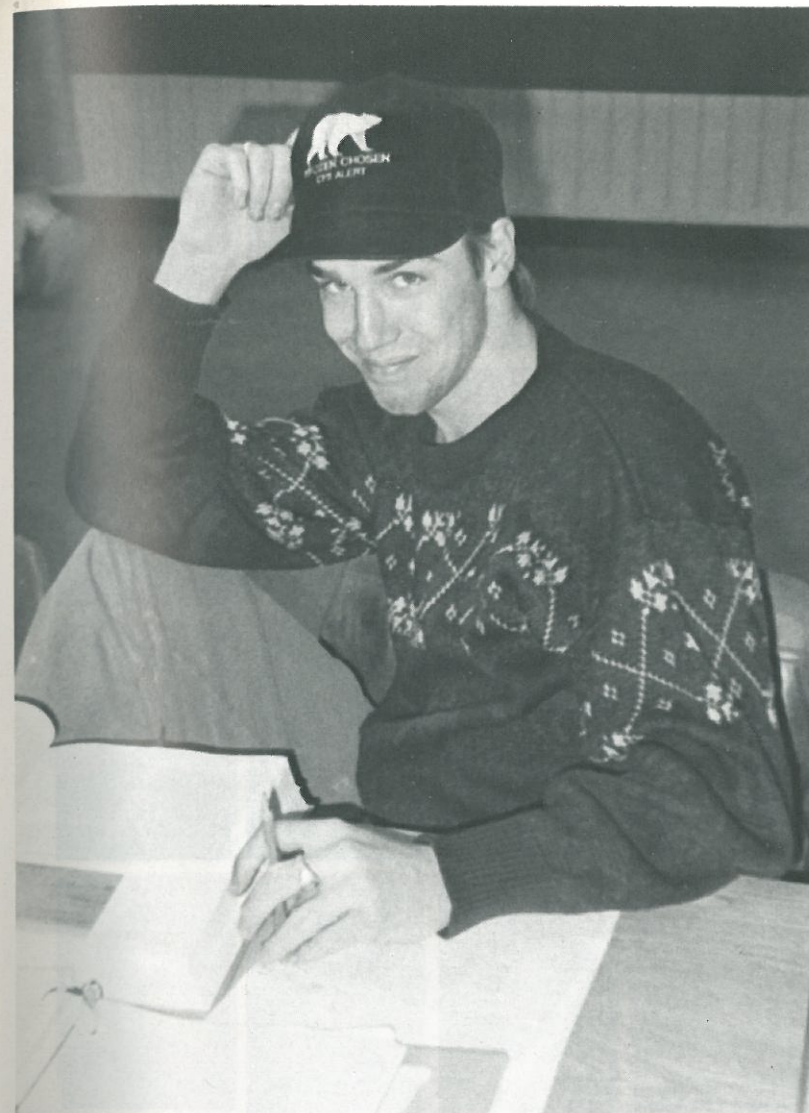

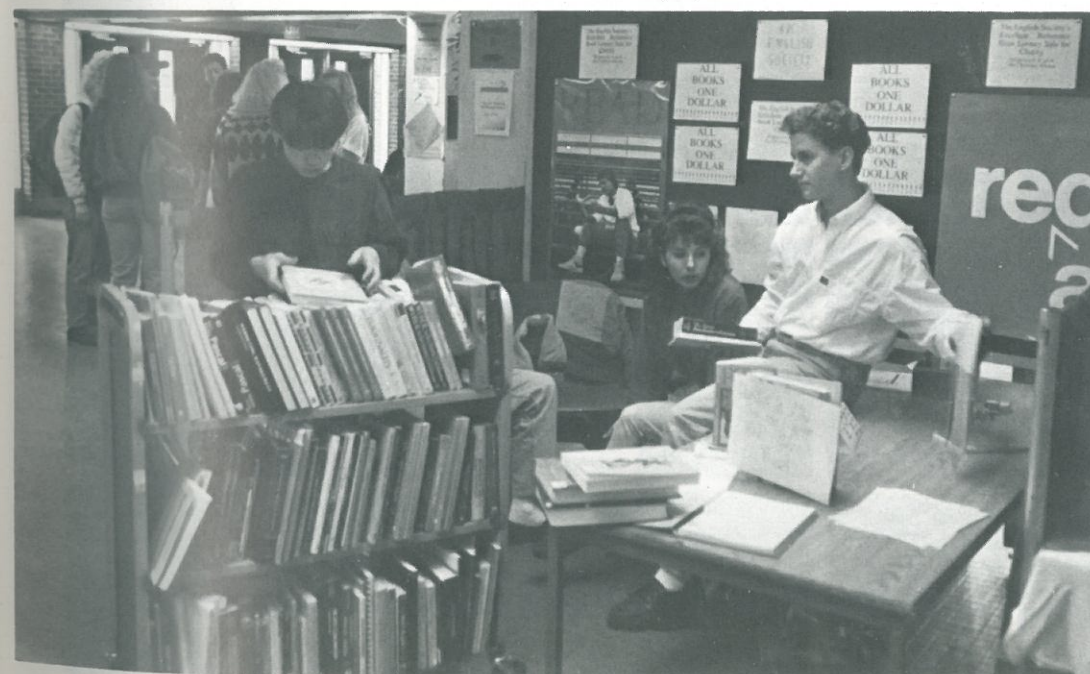

unity and friendship in the entire college. This society of 30 hosted authors, and assisted in setting up booths for Open House and Society Carnival Days.

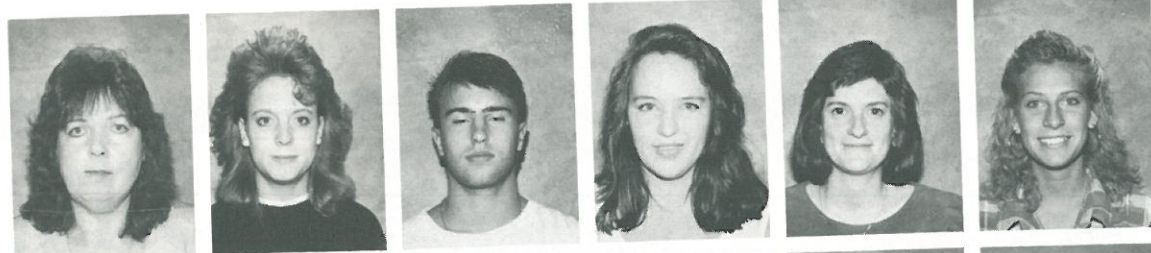

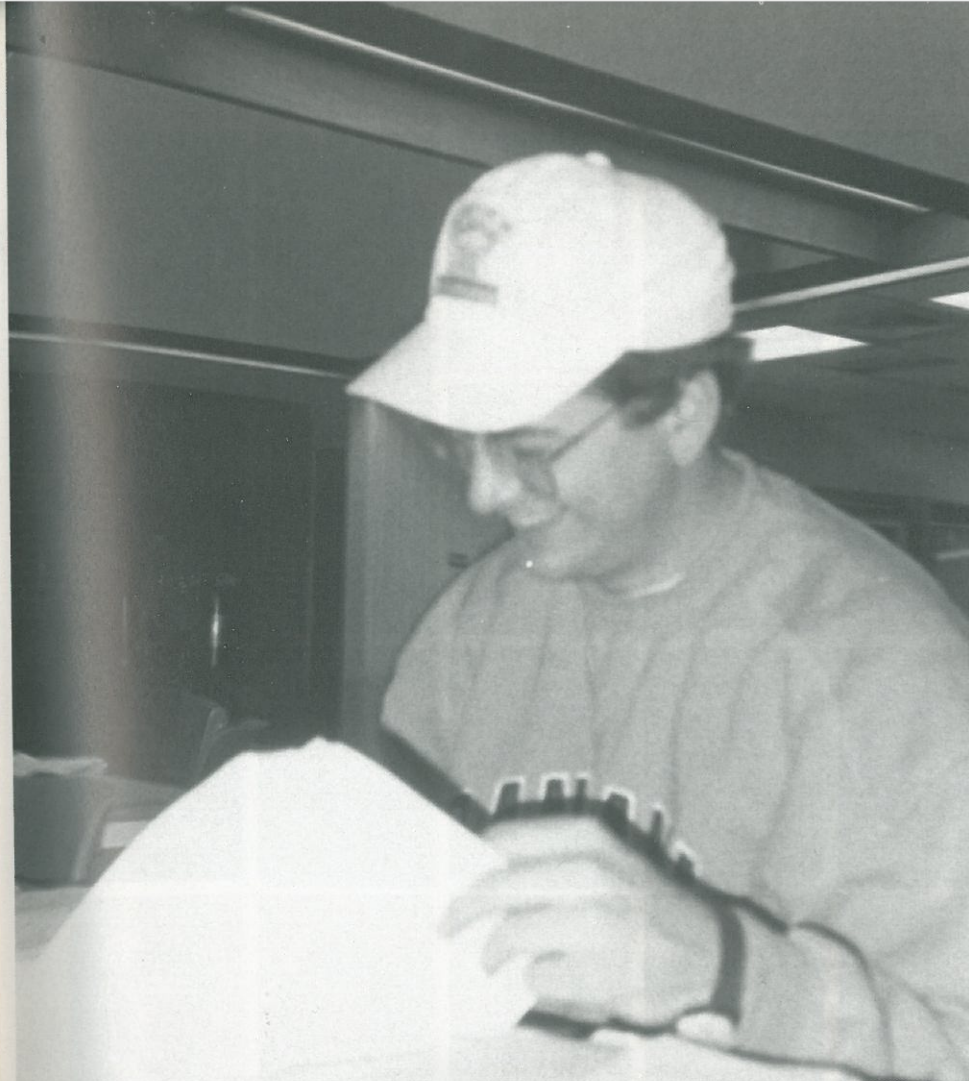
Business & Commerce

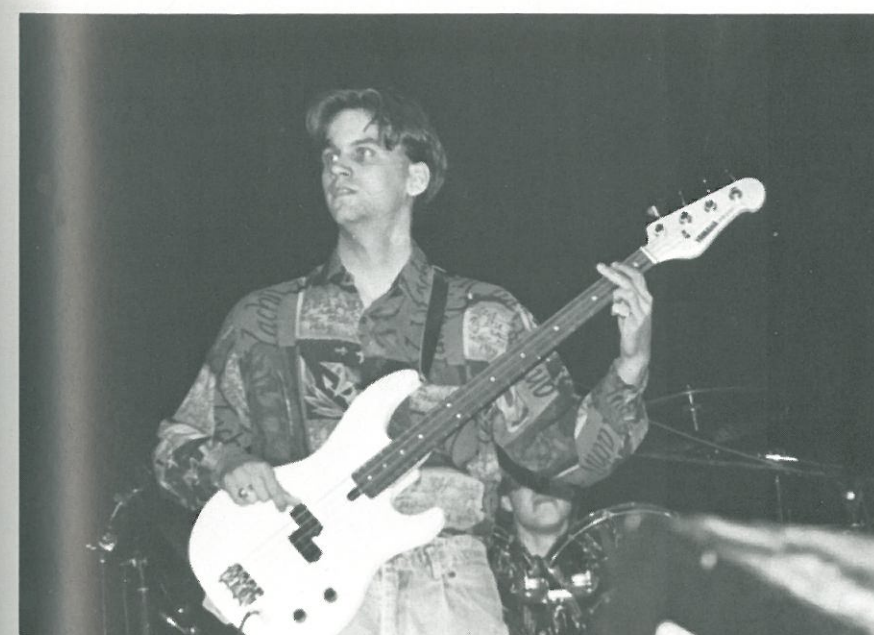
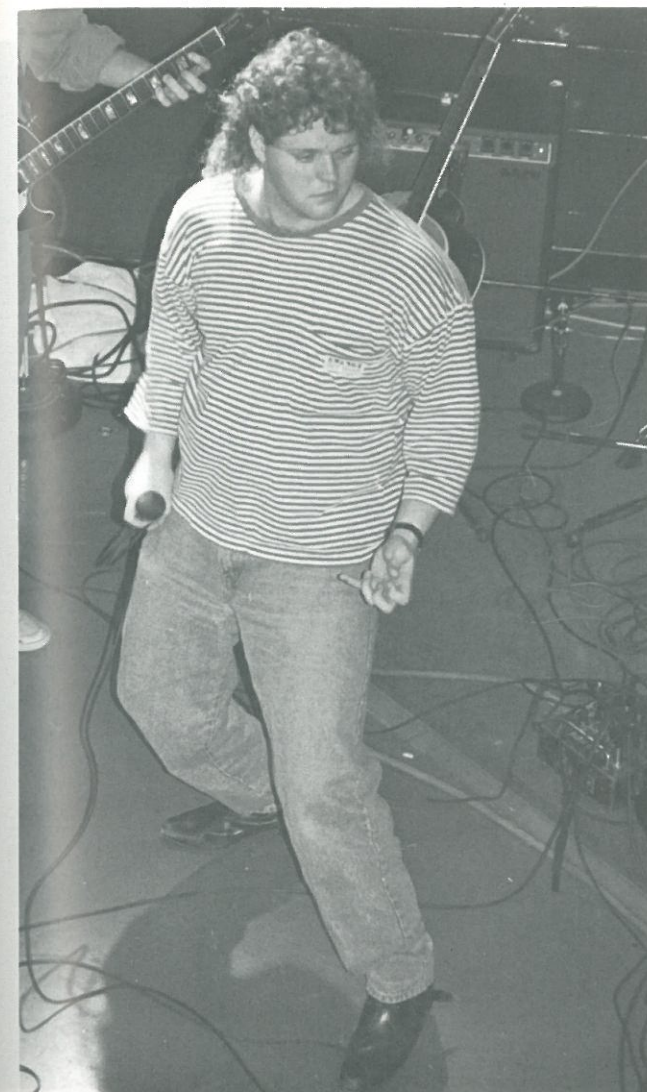


As President of the Music Society, Derek Melchert is responsible for listening and dealing with music society students' concerns. In October, Derek was making decisions over the phone from Saskatoon. Why? Because he was diagnosed with Gillian Barre Syndrome, a virus that attacks the nervous system.

"It was scary when I did not know what I had. I went to three doctors in Red Deer who would not diagnose me. Finally, I went back home to Prince Albert, and my family doctor sent me to the University of Saskatoon Hospital, where I underwent a series of tests to confirm my condition."

The Gillian Barre Syndrome is rare, affecting one in a hundred thousand people. Derek had paralysis, where all of his senses were numbed. His sense of smell and taste were dulled and his speech was severely affected. His friends and family were shocked because he was so active in the music department, having lead vocals in the Noon Shows and Music Pubs.

On November 29th, Derek returned to RDC to perform with the band *Cat's Meow* in the music pub. He sang with great enthusiasm and received much support from the entire audience. "I never lost hope, when I realized how many people believed in me. It is most important to keep the communication lines open with your family when you have a problem. Especially when you are in college, you must keep on trying when times get tough."

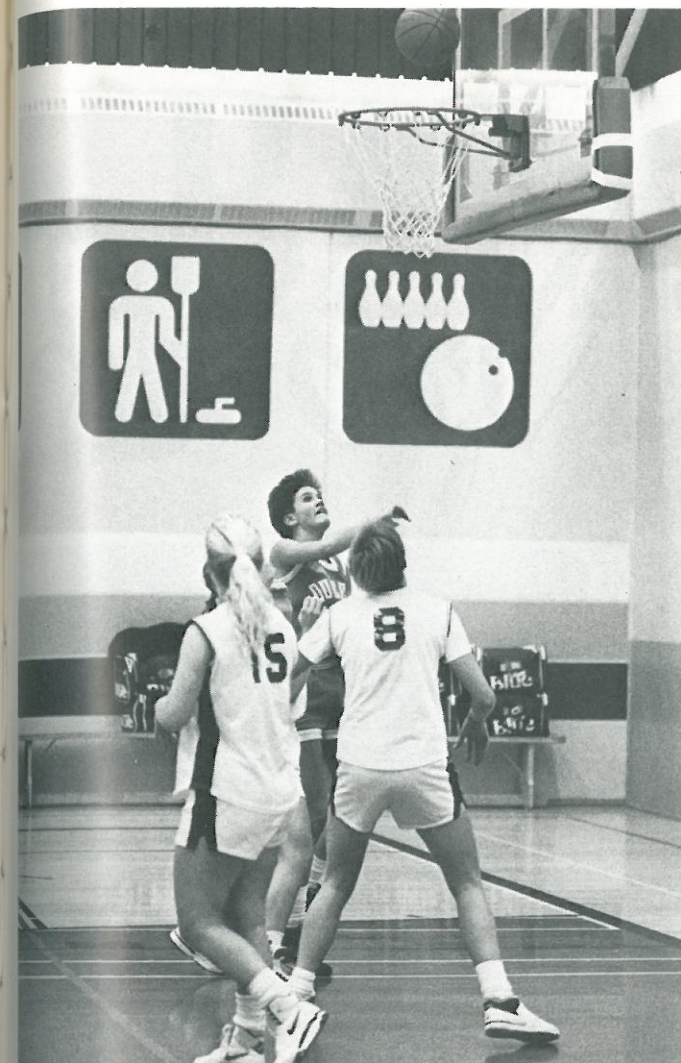

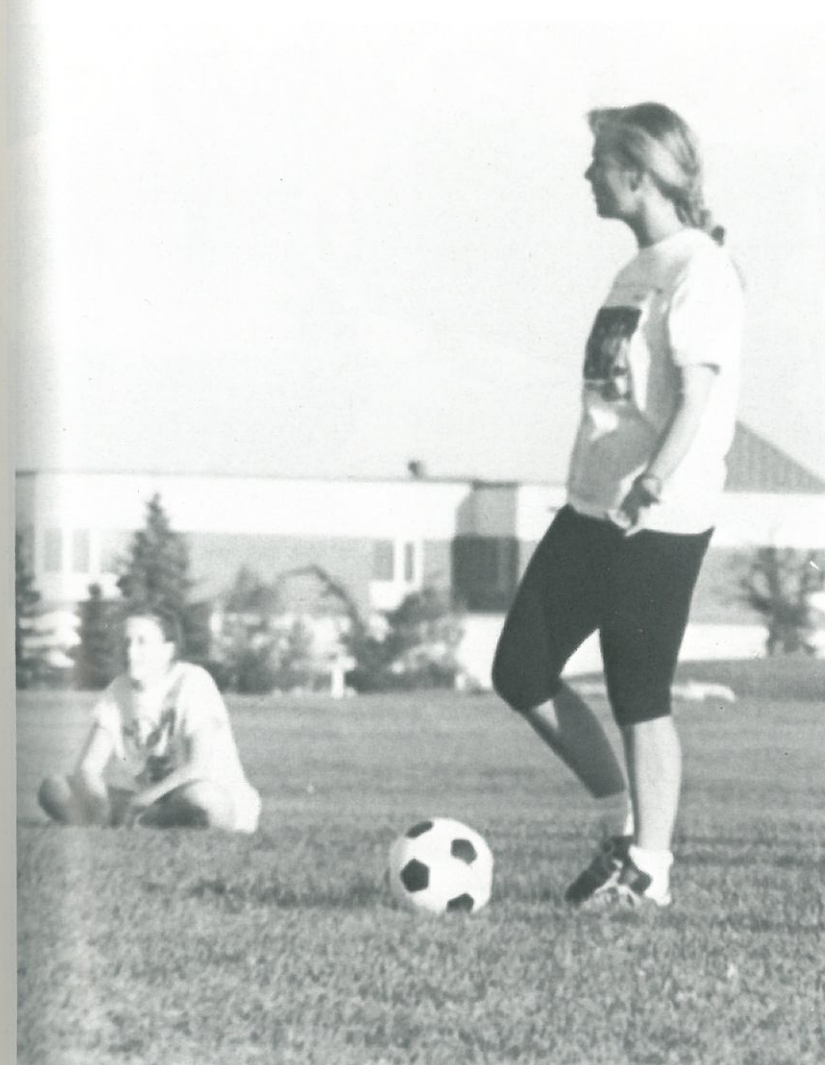
